## CUSTOMIZED AND FACULTY LED PROGRAMS

For the past ten years Universidad de Belgrano has been collaborating with universities abroad to offer customized and faculty led programs, mostly during the summer terms in the Northern Hemisphere (June-August). In these programs, our faculty and the visiting faculty teach at least one course each. Tailored to the visiting institution's needs, programs can range from three weeks to a full semester and contact hours may vary as well from 40 to 80 hours.

Students enjoy an academic environment and mingle with other international students taking semester courses in our Program of Latin American Studies, which receives an international population of more than 300 students per semester.

Students usually attend classes Monday through Thursday and they have access to UB facilities including bookstore library, copy center, computer lab, Wi-Fi connection, food court, cafeteria, and other student services (e.g. travel agency). We recommend that Fridays be reserved for field trips and other urban outings.

We also welcome the opportunity to create other short term formats such as workshops or clinics organized around a series of lectures and outings (e.g. visits to factories).
